April 29<sup>th</sup> 4pm meeting  
Fisherman's Bay

The March 29<sup>th</sup> meeting of Workman Township was called to order by Chairman Jim Berg at 4 pm with the reciting of the pledge of allegiance to the US flag. All board members were in attendance and no citizens or guests were in attendance.

Motion to accept the agenda was made by Supervisor Paris with second by Supervisor Jaworski. The February meeting minutes were read by Clerk Essen with approval by Paris and second by Jaworski. The minutes will stand as read. Treasurer Berg gave the report on finances. The clerk balances and treasurer balances agree. Motion to approve by Jaworski with second by Paris. The treasurer report will stand as read.

Supervisor Jaworski gave his report on the buildings. After some discussion by the board a motion to do some upgrading to the townhall and to possibly add an addition to the garage was made by Supervisor Berg with second by Supervisor Paris. Supervisor Jaworski voted in the negative. Motion carried by 2-1 vote.

Supervisor Paris reported on Lakeview Cemetery and stated that the new flags have arrived and will be installed in a couple weeks. Cleanup of the cemetery will begin after all the snow is melted. Paris noted that the cemetery policies need to be updated. Memorial Day activity has begun with music arranged and contact with the legion and VFW will be made.

Supervisor Berg reported on roads and ditches and indicated that currently the roads and ditches are OK. Efforts will be made to get as much snow off the roads and deposited in the ditches will be made. Contact with several contractors has been made if road problems develop.

Discussion was held on the Annual Meeting and there was agreement that the meeting went well. Only three citizens attended the meeting. They appeared to be satisfied with the operation of the township. No levy increase was requested.

Clerk Essen read the claims to be paid and after some discussion motion was made by Paris with second by Jaworski to pay the claims. Signing of necessary paperwork and checks was completed. Motion to adjourn was made by Paris with second by Jaworski. Meeting adjourned at 4:59 pm.
