The July monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Jim Berg at 4 pm with the pledge of allegiance to the United States Flag. All board members were present. No citizens or guests were present.

Motion to approve the agenda by Supervisor Jaworsky with second by Supervisor Paris. Clerk Essen read the minutes for the previous month. Motion to approve by Jaworsky with second by Paris. The minutes will stand as read. Treasurer Berg gave the financial report. Our CD is coming due. The treasurer and clerk money balances agree with the bank balance. Grader is working without problems. A 15” x by 34' culvert is planned for Grouse Street about a half mile in from Hwy 65. First roadside mowing has been completed. All fire extinguishers on equipment and in buildings have been checked on yearly inspection.

Reading of claims was read by clerk. Motion to approve payment by Paris with second by Jaworsky. All necessary paperwork and checks signed. Next meeting scheduled for Wednesday, August 16th at 4 pm at townhall. Motion to adjourn at 5:07 by Jaworsky with second by Paris.
