The August Board Meeting was called to order by Chairman Berg at 4 pm with all board members present and no citizens or guests present. Motion to accept the agenda was made by Paris with second by Berg. Motion carried. The Workman Township minutes for last month was read by Clerk Essen. Motion to accept the minutes was made by Jaworski with second by Paris. Motion carried. The minutes will stand as read. Treasurer Berg gave the township financial report. The clerk money balances and treasurer money balances agree. Motion to accept the treasurer report was made by Paris with second by Jaworski. Motion carried.

Supervisor Jaworski had no report on buildings, fire, first responders. Supervisor Paris reported that the cemetery is very attractive with township flowers and flowers placed at burial plots all in bloom and very attractive. Watering has been done as needed. Plans are underway to attend the annual Minnesota Association of Cemeteries meeting in September. Supervisor Berg reported on grader and snowplow repair. Roads are in good shape. Dry conditions are causing the roads to be very dusty. Excessive speeding does not help. A culvert on Grouse Street will be placed in the next few weeks. The second roadside mowing will start in early October.

Clerk Essen read the Claims to be paid and after review motion was made by Jaworski with second by Paris to pay the Claims.

Voyager Press has agreed to prepare a history of our township to be placed on our website. Review of old records. Interviewing of long established citizens has begun. Cost for the research work will be \$600, which was approved.
